We are writing to share an important update regarding the upcoming academic year. Our inpatient training sites for both Family Medicine and Obstetrics will be undergoing transitions. VMFH St. Joseph Medical Center, our current inpatient hospital partner, has notified us that they will be terminating the affiliation agreement with CHC and will no longer support non-VMFH learners effective July 1, 2026. This change has prompted us to explore new pathways for these two curricula.

We are actively engaging with several hospital systems in our region to identify strong alternatives. While no final agreements have been reached yet, our commitment remains unwavering: to provide a comprehensive and exceptional full-spectrum- family medicine education.


If you would like to hear our residents' perspectives on how this transition may shape their training experience, they are available to speak with you or connect via email.
